1. STAND WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

As he spoke, the Spirit came into me and raised me to my feet, and I heard him speaking to me.

Ezekiel 2:2

- Listen to the Word

And he said to me, “Son of man, eat what is before you, eat this scroll; then go and speak to the house of Israel.”

Ezekiel 3:1

- Internalize the Word

He led me back and forth among them, and I saw a great many bones on the floor of the valley, bones that were very dry.

Ezekiel 37:2

2. YIELD TO THE HOLY SPIRIT’S POWER

He asked me, “Son of man, can these bones live?”

I said, “O Sovereign LORD, you alone know.”

Ezekiel 37:3

“How can this be?” Nicodemus asked. “You are Israel’s teacher,” said Jesus, “and do you not understand these things?”

- **God’s plans and purposes will happen**

3. SPEAK GOD’S WORD INTO THE DRY PLACES

Then he said to me, “Prophecy to these bones and say to them, ‘Dry bones, hear the word of the LORD!’”

Ezekiel 37:4

- **God brings life to lifeless situations**

This is what the Sovereign LORD says to these bones: I will make breath enter you, and you will come to life.

Ezekiel 37:5

- **Speak to the Wind**

“...This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe into these slain, that they may live.”
