1. LEARN THE LANGUAGE OF THE SPIRIT

- Reference God’s map the Bible

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.

Psalm 119:105

- Test for the Holy Spirit

And asked them, “Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?” They answered, “No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit.”

Acts 19:2

2. SEEK THE DIRECTION OF THE SPIRIT

- Spirit-driven vs. Self-reliant

So he said to me, “This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: ‘Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,’ says the LORD Almighty.”

Zechariah 4:6

3. YIELD TO THE SPIRIT’S DIRECTION

- Pro-active in faith

a. Ask for the fullness of God’s Spirit
