### Live in God's Freedom by ...

#### 1. Using God's Word as guide for daily living

To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples."  
John 8:31

- **Avoid the traps of religion and entitlement**

They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing him.  
John 8:6

They answered him, "We are Abraham's descendants and have never been slaves of anyone."  
John 8:33a

- **Live by faith not by sight**

"If you were Abraham's children," said Jesus, "then you would do the things Abraham did."  
John 8:39b

By faith Abraham, even though he was past age—and Sarah herself was barren—was enabled to become a father because he considered him faithful who had made the promise.  
Hebrews 11:11

#### 2. Working for the priorities on God's heart

The one who sent me is with me; he has not left me alone, for I always do what pleases him.  
John 8:29

- **God's heart breaks for the poor and oppressed**

Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter— when you see the naked, to clothe him, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood?  
Isaiah 58:7

- **God's grace is a license to love not sin**

You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love.  
Galatians 5:13

#### 3. Sharing your witness of Jesus to a lost world

I am telling you what I have seen in the Father's presence, and you do what you have heard from your father.  
John 8:38
