HOW CAN I HAVE A HEART LIKE JESUS?

1. You must care about what Jesus cares about

“Be full of love for others, following the example of Christ who loved you and gave himself to God as a sacrifice to take away your sins.”
Ephesians 5:2 (LB)

- **Jesus cares about the world**

“When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.”
Matthew 9:36

- **Jesus loves his church**

“... Christ loved the church and gave his life for her.”
Ephesians 5:25 (TEV)

2. You must be indifferent to what Jesus is indifferent to

- **Jesus was indifferent to impressing people**

“Your approval or disapproval means nothing to me.”
John 5:41 (NLT)

- **Jesus was indifferent to getting rich**

“Life is not measured by how much one owns.”
Luke 12:15 (NCV)

3. You must get angry about what angers Jesus

“Be angry without sinning.”
Ephesians 4:26 (GWT)

- **When the needs of children go unmet**

“People brought children to Jesus, hoping he might touch them, but the disciples scolded them. When Jesus saw this, he was indignant. He said ... ‘Don’t push these children away! Don’t ever get between them and me. These children are at the very center of life in the kingdom.’”
Mark 10:13-14 (MSG)

- **When the suffering of others is ignored**

“Jesus said, ‘... Woe to you, because you load people down with burdens they can hardly carry, and you yourselves will not lift one finger to help them.’”
Luke 11:46

4. You have to sacrifice for what Jesus sacrificed

“If you try to keep your life for yourself, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake and for the sake of the Good News, you will find true life.”
Mark 8:35 (NLT)

Equip servant leaders
Assist the poor
Care for the sick
Educate the young
